Dear Friends and Colleagues

Greetings. As we prepare for our next activity and event let me give some guidance as to what to expect from our Egyptian and European partners. We agreed during the Kick off meeting to reduce the travel time and hence the coaching time to a smaller amount of days with the caveat that each day would be a long intensive one which would therefore contain four working sessions from nine in the morning till seven in the evening with a tentative schedule that would look like the following:

session 1:	9am to 11am
session 2:	11:30am to 13:30 pm
LUNCH	13:30pm to 15:00 pm
session 3:	15:00pm to 17:00 pm
session 4:	17:00pm to 19:00 pm

The first two sessions would be largely continuing the work done on ethnographies and needs assessment for schools. We therefore suggest:

1. Egyptian partners should already prepare some queries and themes they would like the European partners to address and send those.
2. European partners should come prepared to tailor their coaching content to the learning needs of their colleagues in Egypt and also to brief on the EU code of ethics for research.

The remaining six sessions should be focused on the development of Mentors and Coaches. We therefore suggest :

1. Egyptian partners to already send the profile of the potential 8 mentors in their institute
2. European partners to come prepared with rich presentations including audio visual materials and possibly perform some role play to demonstrate the role and performance of mentors.

Hoping this will be a most enjoyable experience for all partners

On another note I would like to thank all those who have sent their signed partnership agreement and urge those that have not to do so very soon as we are already past the deadline.
