Greetings. Congratulations to all for the successful workshops held in Ain Shams, Helwan and Alexandria Universities. Despite the slow and difficult start, work is clearly underway and needing more of course in the way of adaptation as we get more engaged and move to different stages of our journey together. We have agreed with our European partners that as a next step they will be sending reports of each of the workshops in each of the Egyptian universities along with their own evaluation. We have also agreed with Leicester that the evaluation forms will be revised for the forthcoming events and activities.

For our Egyptian partners we would like to suggest that we use the tool already shared with you during the first local management meeting for the school demography for a rapid baseline study while adding three questions around whether the schools have Peer Communities of Learners, Mentors and how many, and finally information around the quality assurance units.
